If you aren't at auditions, you can't be in this fun and exuberant show! So be there! In average years, there are between 30 to 35 acts and MCs who audition for 14-15 available slots in the show and the two MC teams. While costumes and props are not required for auditions, the acts that tend to be chosen are those who are best prepared...so, give us your best shot * (No more than 5 people per act.)

*Audition forms are pre-numbered so you can choose close to when you want to audition in the pack.

Follies Act Selection Process An oversight group consisting of the Producer, Director, Sound Director, Lighting Director, Videographer and Stage Managers make recommendations based on auditions. The Director makes final act selection and builds the show based on those recommendations.

Roles – Each cast/crew member may only fulfill a single main role in the Follies to maximize the number of people who can participate in the Follies production. Each year, a whopping 110 dedicated, awesome folks make up the cast and crew.

Content – Acts are given maximum leeway on content. however, the Follies reserves the right to censor material deemed to be “too socially unacceptable.” (Yes, that is possible!)

If chosen for this year's Follies show, you will need to be at the all-important first rehearsal to get signed up and “indoctrinated.”

Policy for Cast Ticket Sales - Each cast and crew member may buy, at full price (\$20 each), four (4) tickets to any regular show in advance of public ticket sales. Cast and crew members also receive two (2) free tickets each to the Media Preview show and (2) free tickets to the Friends and Family night. The order of ticket sales will be determined by drawing a number from a “hat” at the first rehearsal. One numbered ticket will be drawn by a representative from each act and crew group who will then purchase their four (4) cast tickets in that order.
